INTRODUCTION

`connect-markdown-renderer` is a small library that allow to render markdown documents in a terminal shell.

REQUIREMENTS

`connect-markdown-renderer` requires Python 3.6+ and depends on the following libraries:

- `ansicolors` $\geq 1.1.8, < 2$
- `mistune` $\leq 0.8.4$
- `pygments` $\geq 2.7.1 < 3$

INSTALL

connect-markdown-renderer can be installed from pypi.org with pip:

```
$ pip install connect-markdown-renderer
```


USAGE EXAMPLE

```
from cmr import render

my_md = """

# Heading level 1 - Paragraph

This is a paragraph.

## Heading level 2 - Lists

*Ordered list:*

1. First item
2. Second item
3. Third item

**Unordered list:**

* First
* Second
* Third

"""

print(render(my_md))
```

This code will produce the following output:

This is a paragraph.

Heading level 2 - Lists

Ordered list:

1. First item
2. Second item
3. Third item

Unordered list:

- First
- Second
- Third

LIMITATIONS

`connect-markdown-renderer` does not support:

- Inline HTML
- Footnotes
